WHAT IS SCRIP?

Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that enables families to raise money for their non-profit organization. Scrip is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.

You purchase gift cards from your organization at face value, and your Scrip Coordinator orders those cards from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced price. The difference is an instant rebate for your organization. It's really that simple.

Scrip is issued by the national and local retailers where many of you already shop—Sam's, Wal-Mart, Starbucks, and Old Navy—to name a few. These merchants want to support non-profit organizations such as our band, and, in return, they ask you to support them by shopping with scrip at their stores.

Great Lakes Scrip Center offers over 300 of the country's biggest brands, including grocery, department stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels, home improvement, and more. Each retailer determines the percentage of credit we receive. You can check the current retailer list available on-line at www.glscrip.com to determine current percentage amounts.

Just by using scrip to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can easily raise \$500 or more per year. It's time to put your shopping dollars to work!

And remember, you are not spending anymore than you would if you were using cash, AND you will be helping all interested students participate

WHERE do I start?

1. Set up a shop with scrip account. You must first set up a free account at shop-withscrip.com and identify yourself as a member of our organization by using Enrollment Code # 5DE79F1B44157.
2. Go to www.shopwithscrip.com, and click on the Register button at the top right of the home page. Under the question "Would you like to join your group's existing program?", click on Join a Scrip Program.
3. Enter the Band's enrollment code (given above) and follow the simple registration instructions and accept the terms and conditions of using the site.
4. Begin Shopping. Just click on the Shop tab at the top of the home page.
5. When it is time to pay, you can

set up your Presto Pay account so that you can quickly and easily pay for your purchases on-line. With a Presto Pay account, your checking account is immediately debited for the face value of your scrip order, plus a small convenience fee of 39 cents when you submit your order. Your bank will show payment to GLSC—Great Lakes Scrip Center.
